

Suspect sketch released after realtor attacked on the job

SMYRNA, Ga. –

Cobb County Police have released a sketch of the man accused of robbing and trying to sexually assault a real estate agent in Smyrna.

According to investigators, the man entered the office of a new subdivision near Cheyenne Drive shortly before 4 p.m. on June 30 and struck up a conversation with a female realtor.

Cobb County Police Officer Mike Bowman said the suspect then pulled out a gun, robbed the woman and forced her into a bathroom, where he tried to sexually assault her.

The realtor managed to get away, escaping out the back door of the office.

She described her attacker as a black man in his late 20's or early 30's who was wearing a white hat, white T-shirt and dark pants during the attack.
